This legislation would negatively impact job creators in Michigan by creating new layers of regulation and exposing licensed professionals to unnecessary legal risk. Industries already regulated by state boards should not be subjected to duplicative standards that could confuse enforcement and complicate compliance for small businesses working hard to operate responsibly.

As you know, our region is home to many small and mid-sized businesses that drive economic opportunity and community development. These businesses need certainty, not added red tape. SB 134 would undercut our state's reputation as a place that supports entrepreneurs, workers, and employers alike.
