Dear Members of the Lansing City Council,

On behalf of the Lansing Regional Chamber of Commerce, we strongly encourage you to vote in support of the following two resolutions on your agenda for Monday, April 7, 2025:

- **Agenda Item 18:** *Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate; transfer from Ultium Cells, LLC to LG Energy Solution Michigan, Inc. at 8100 Davis Hwy. (PEND-3983)*
- **Agenda Item 19:** *Renaissance Zone; transfer from Ultium Cells, LLC to LG Energy Solution Michigan, Inc. at 8100 Davis Hwy. (PEND-3984)*

We strongly encourage you to vote in support of the transfer of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate from Ultium Cells, LLC to LG Energy Solution Michigan, Inc., for the \$2.6 billion battery manufacturing facility located at 8100 Davis Hwy in Lansing / Delta Township.

This transformational project is at 98 percent completion and has been built entirely through union labor, with as many as 1,700 trades workers on site at peak construction phase in early 2024. In March 2024, the project surpassed 2 million construction building hours.

The project is expected to support up to 1,700 permanent full-time jobs with strong wages in our region. Delay or failure to approve this transfer jeopardizes the long-term viability of the facility and the significant investment already made.

This is a critical vote for the future of our economy and workforce—and one the Chamber is strongly supportive of.
